Item No. 6

Activities initiated and implemented by the IQAC

The Committee noted the activities initiated and implemented by the IQAC.

The following deliberations were made by the Committee:

- > The Director, IQAC has presented to the Committee various initiatives of the IQAC in enhancing quality of teaching, research and governance in the University
- > The Committee stressed the need for documentation of the IQAC events and achievements.
- ➤ The Chairman informed the Committee that the University of Hyderabad has achieved the status of Institute of Eminence (IoE) and stressed the role of IQAC in achieving the objectives of IoE. IQAC should also play an active role in recruitment of faculty, design of curriculum, building and improving research so as to reach the goals set for IoE.
- The IQAC should work closely with the Chairman and other members of the Empowered Committee for Differently Abled Persons (ECDAP) to improve the facilities to the differently abled students. The Committee requested the IQAC to have a data base of the various initiatives undertaken by ECDAP.
- ➤ The Committee deliberated in detail about Student feedback, Alumni Affairs, Outcome-Based Education (OBE), Plagiarism issues, Predatory journals, CARE List of Journals, Incentives to the faculty to encourage teaching and research, etc.
- > The Committee suggested that the R&D section of the University may provide all the details regarding projects and research to the IQAC.
- > The Committee felt the need for organizing academic writing and research methodology workshops to all the research scholars in order to improve their research and writing skills.

Award of UGC-PARAMARSH Scheme for Mentoring NAAC Accreditation Aspirant Institutions to promote Quality Assurance in Higher Education

The Director, IQAC informed the Committee about UGC-PARAMASH Scheme of UGC to mentor 5 educational institutions to help them in getting accreditation by the NAAC.
