The Director IQAC welcomed the members and requested the Vice-Chancellor to give his opening remarks.

The VC underlined the importance and the role played by the IQAC and the need for its message to be taken across the University Community

The Director informed the members of the various activities of the IQAC since the previous meeting. These activities were conducted by various units across the University, with the support of the IQAC.

 The Members confirmed the minutes and ATR of the previous IQAC meeting held in November 2024. Further, it has been decided to include SDG component addressed in the PhD thesis in the certificate included in the thesis (A draft certificate is enclosed for the review)

- 2) The Committee was informed that the IQAC has submitted data for the NIRF rankings in January 2025.
- 3) It also informed that QS rankings is submitted earlier of this month. A brief discussion of the QS rankings and publications. The Committee suggested that the University use international abstract and citation databases like Scopus and Web of Science as markers for assessing publications both recruitment and promotions. Publications in internationally recognized databases are more likely to help the University improve its rankings.

It was suggested that the IQAC reach out to the University Community and inform them about the finer details of rankings and the implications. Based on the weightage of parameters used in different disciplines. Two meetings could be conducted with the disciplines focusing on weightage given to academic reputation and research publications and citations.

- 4) Members were informed that the data collection for Times Higher Education is under process
- 5) As per the decision of earlier IQAC committee, a third party has been empaneled, the Green mentors have evaluated the data provided as per their requirement and Platinum rank has been awarded. The detailed evaluation will be uploaded on the University website as soon as the necessary formalities are completed.
- 6) The University Engineer made a brief presentation on UoH's attempt to become a greener and cleaner campus. Movement on this is likely to help the University closer to achieving UN SDGs. (more information on this may be obtained from the UE)
- 7) Director (CC, CNF) informed the Committee of the proposal to build a new University website has been initiated, the mock-ups were shown to committee. It was informed that the main landing page requires to be reviewed and approved by the Registrar and VC as certain mandatory requirements of MoE need to be complied by the University. Members suggested that a feedback on the design and user interface be obtained from the students, staff and faculty.
- 8) The Director IQAC thanked the members for their time and valuable inputs over the last two years. This was the last meeting of the IQAC Committee (2023-25).
